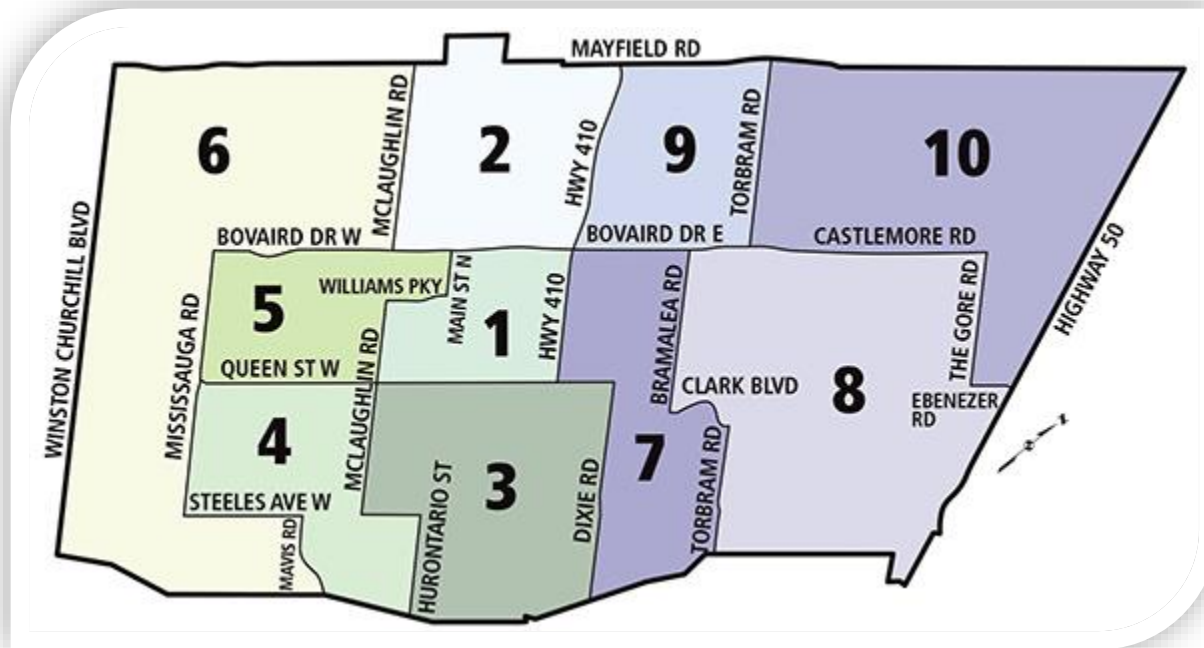

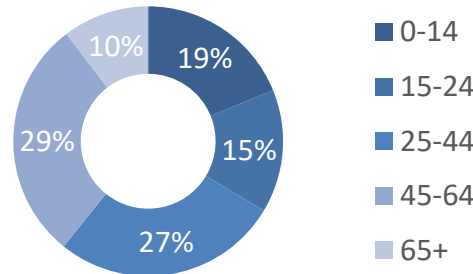

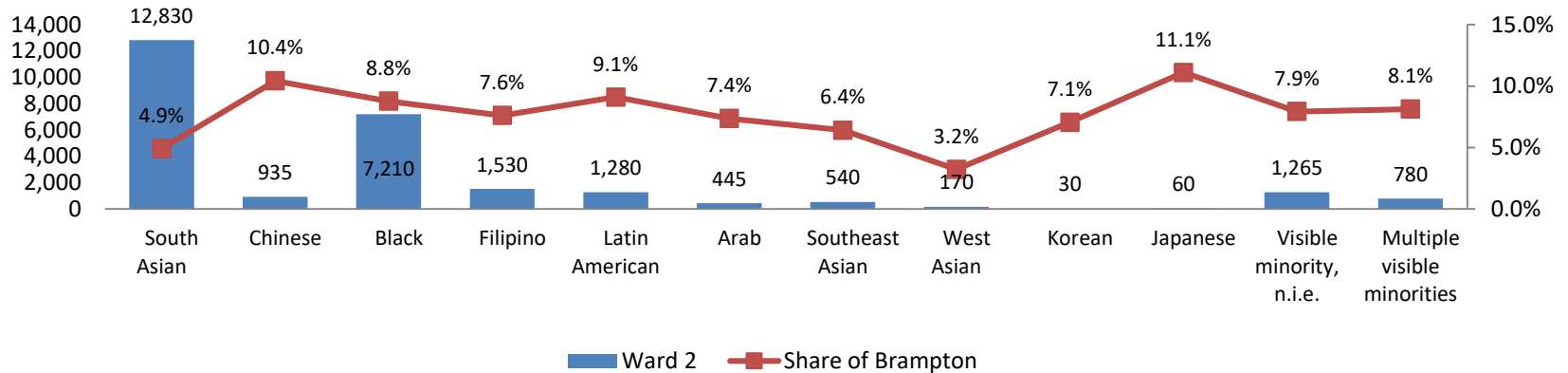

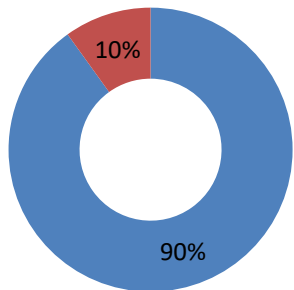

(Ward 2)**



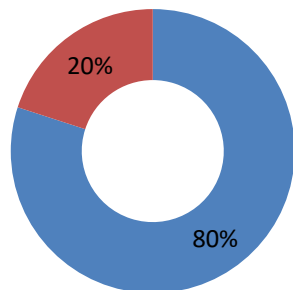

(Ward 2)**



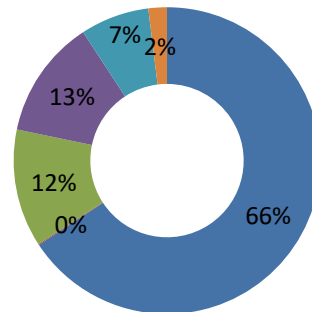

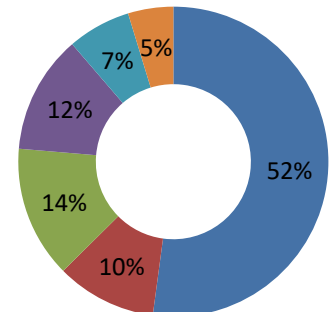

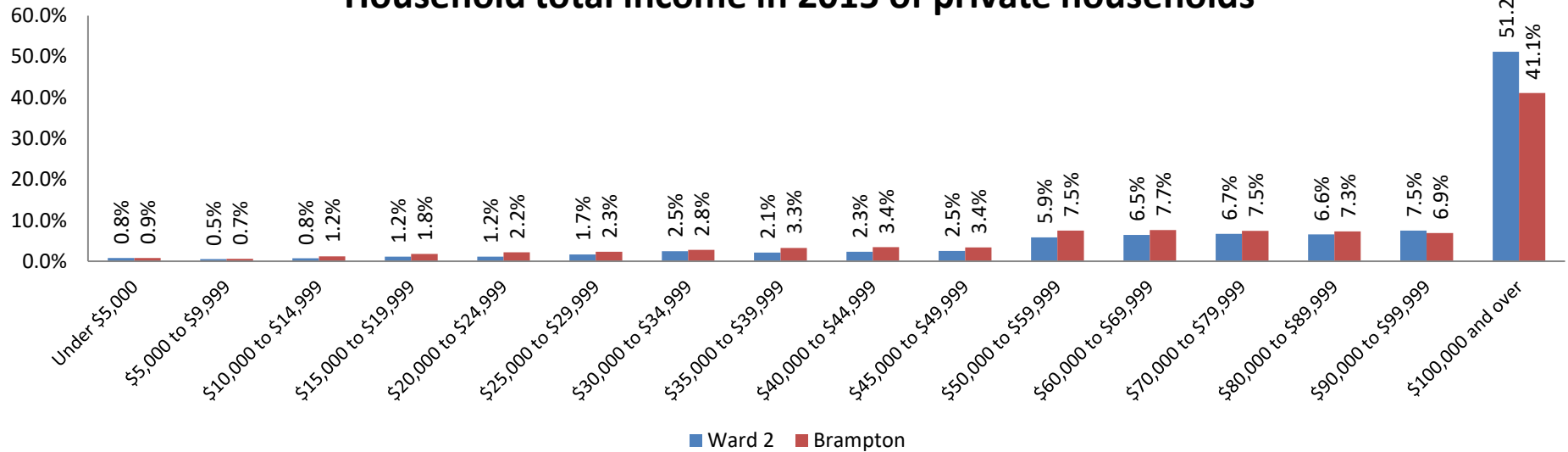

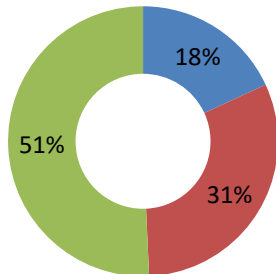

Household total income in 2015 of private households

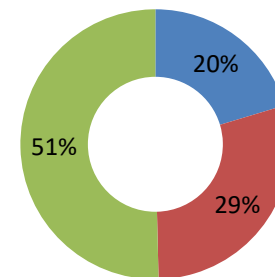
