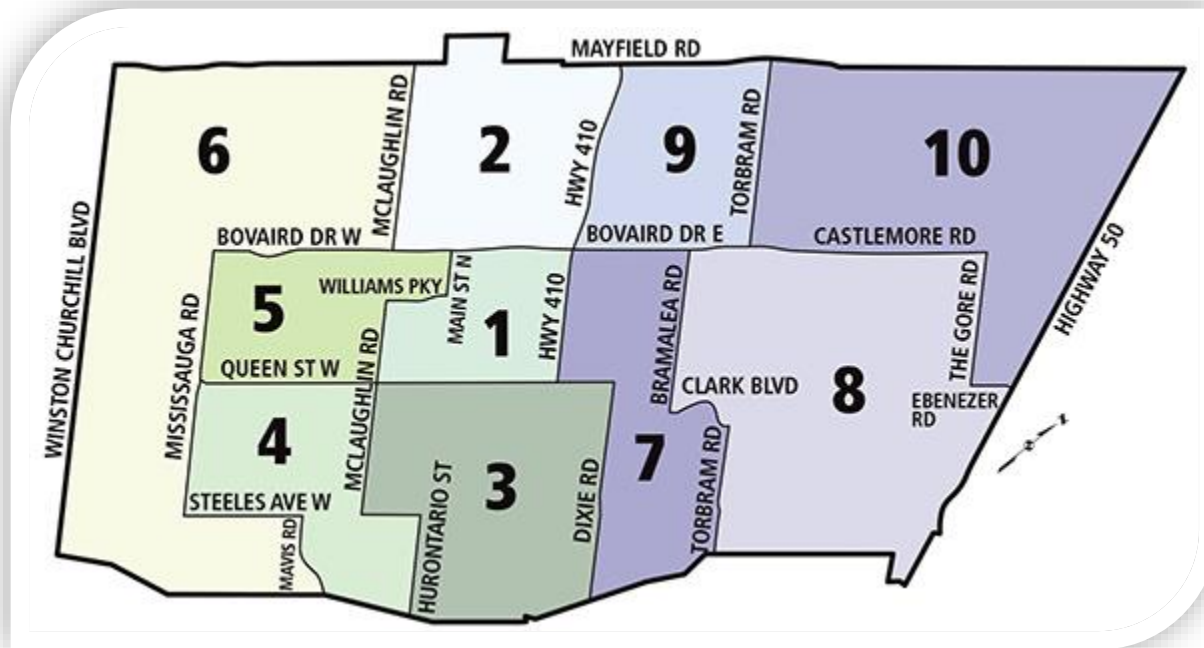

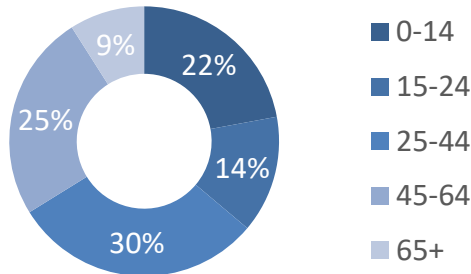

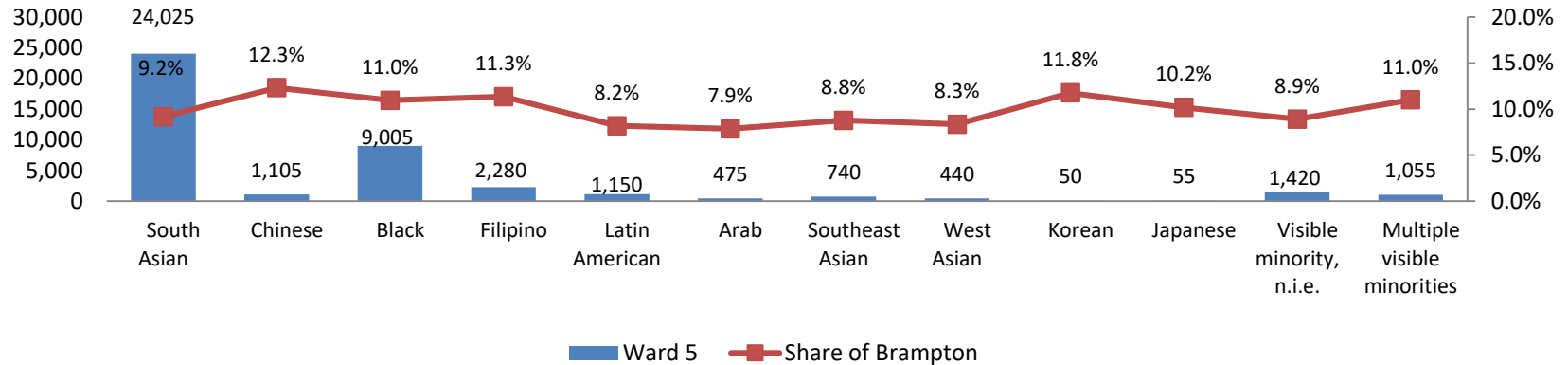

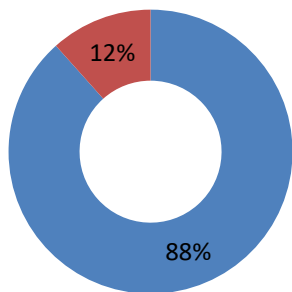

2016 Total population in by visible minority (Ward 5)



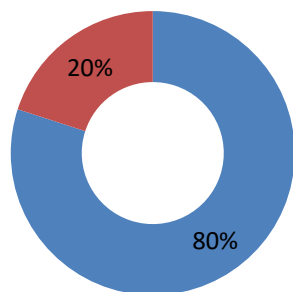

2016 Owners vs Renter (Ward 5)



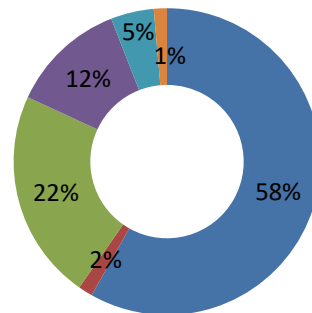

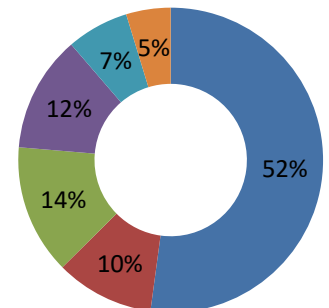

Type of dwelling (Ward 5)



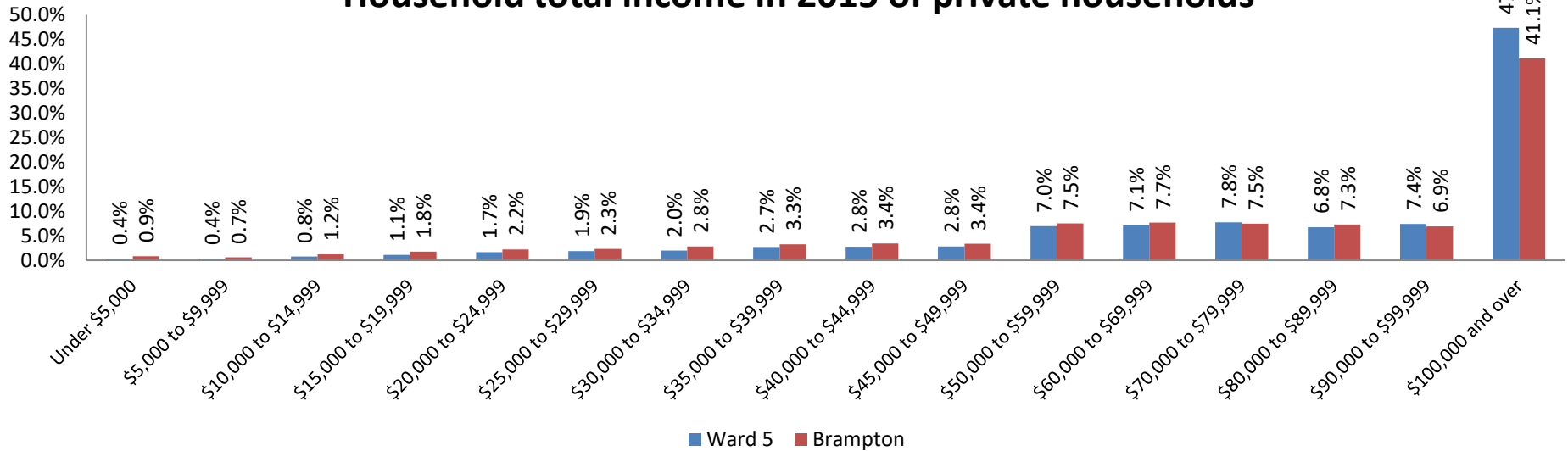

Type of dwelling (Brampton)



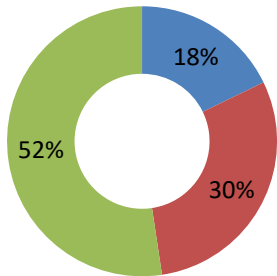

Household total income in 2015 of private households

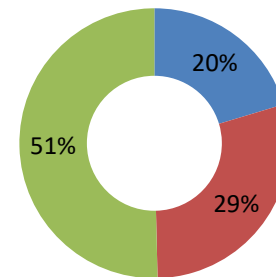
