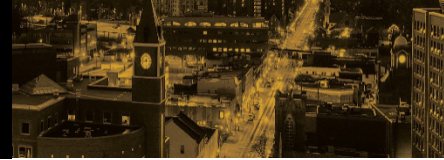

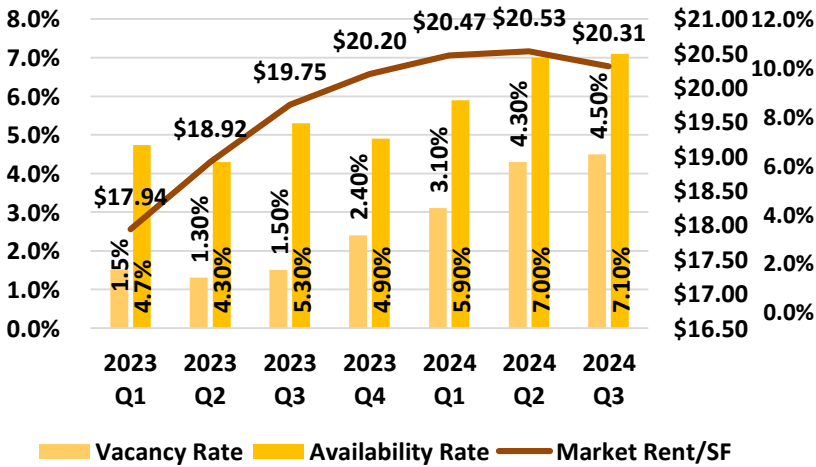

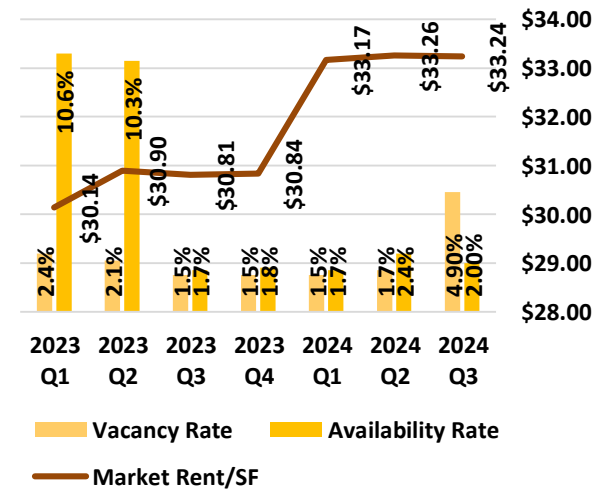

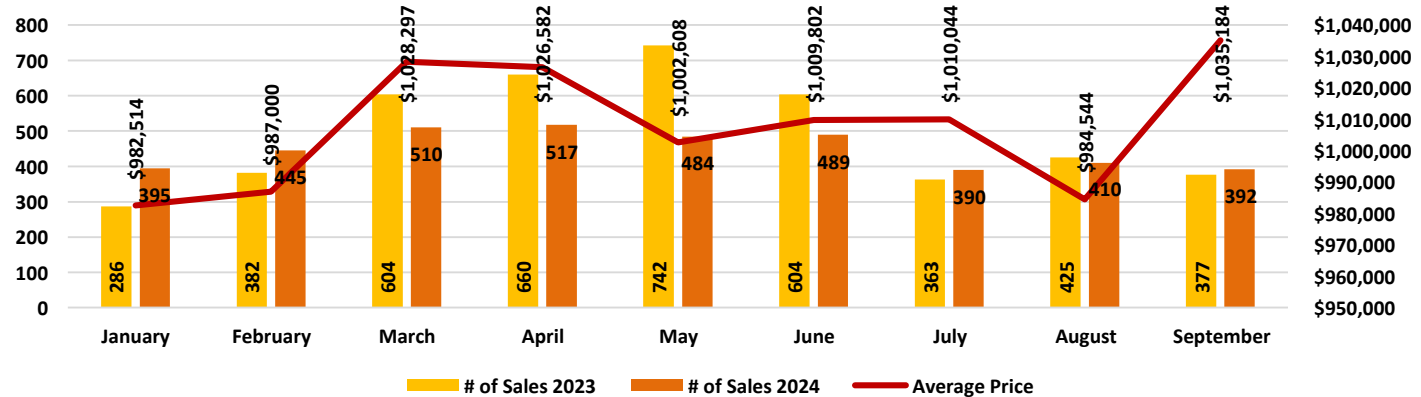
Brampton Industrial Submarket

Brampton Home Sales and Average Price Trend 2024 QTD

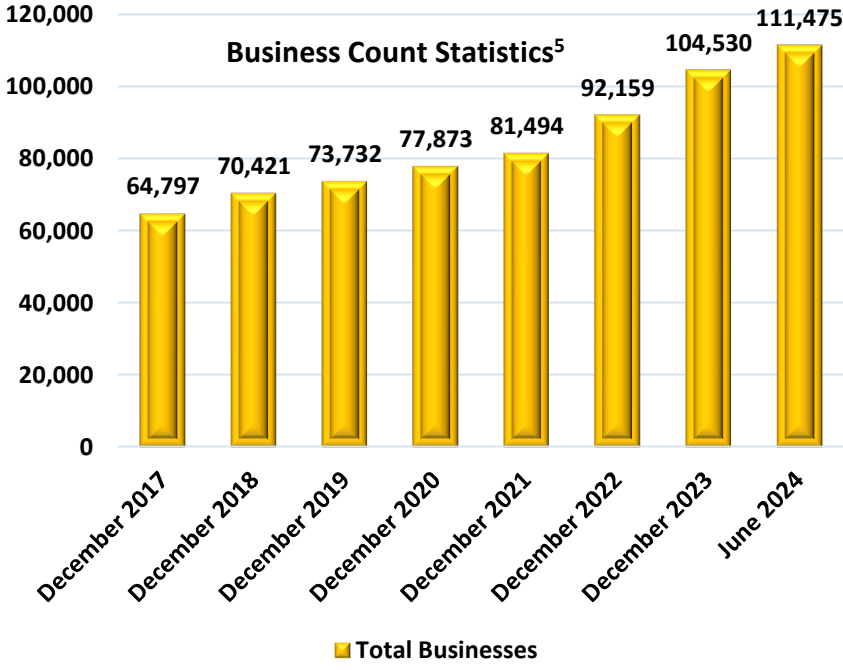
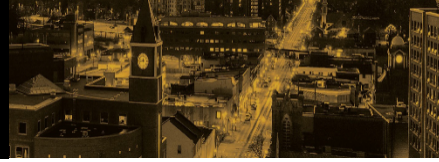

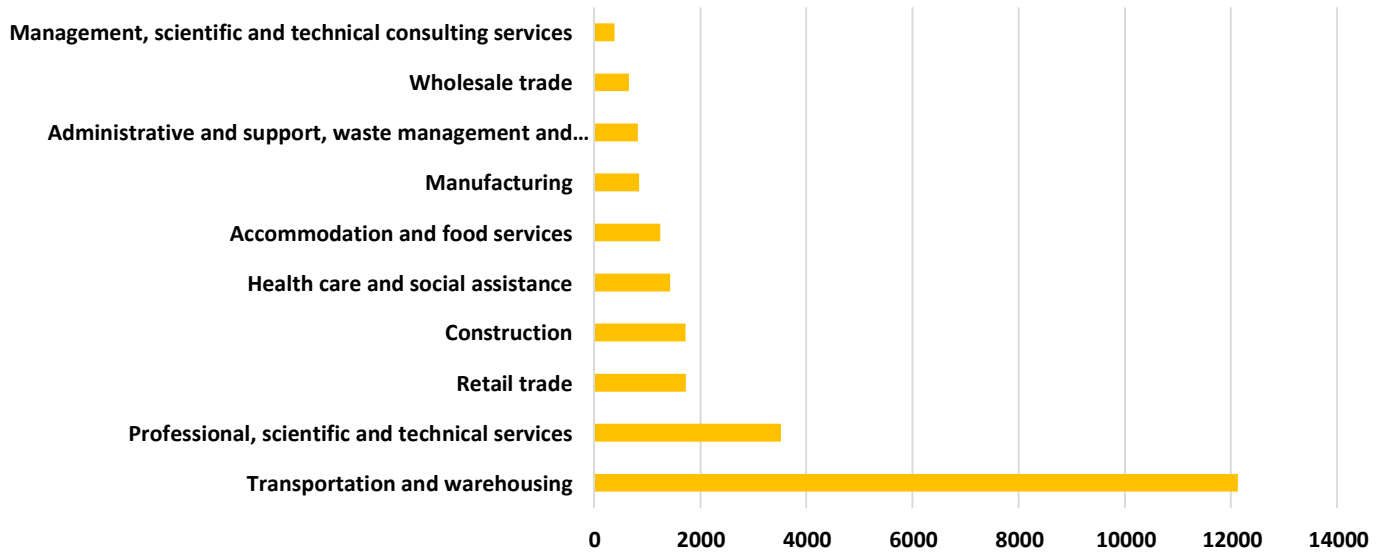
